### Who can participate?

New entrepreneurs (NE): entrepreneurs active for less than 3 years (start-ups/business transfers) or Wannabe


(receiving a monthly financial assistance from the programme to cover travel, housing and subsistence expenses during the time of the stay with the host entrepreneur)

Host entrepreneurs (HE): experienced entrepreneurs active for more than 3 years









Facilitators: Intermediary Organisations (currently not in Luxembourg, Israel, Norway, Liechtenstein, Iceland, Montenegro, Albania, Serbia), Support Office, EASME







### The 4 Steps of an Exchange








#### **STEP 1: Online application**

- Application from NE (business plan, CV, motivation)
- 2. Application checked by IO
- 3. HE states interest to participate (CV and motivation)
- 4. File is checked by IO.




#### **STEP 2: Matching**

Matching of NE and HE with the help of the 2 IOs

# STEP 3: Contracting and preparation

- 1. HE, NE and IOs establish agreements
- 2. NE does pre-departure induction
- 3. NE receives a grant.







#### **STEP 4: Stay abroad**

- 1. Duration: 1-6 months
- 2. On-the-job training, work on concrete projects
- On-site support provided to the NE by the Host IO
- 4. Reporting about the exchange.





### **Expected Output**

Participation of around 700 New Entrepreneurs in the Programme

## Main steps to follow for NE & HE to participate

- Preparation of application documents: curriculum vitae, motivation and, a business plan (for NE)
- > Registration via the online form and submission of CV and business plan (for NE only)
- > Build a relationship with a new or host entrepreneur abroad (<u>two options</u>):

a) You suggest to your local contact point a new or host entrepreneur with whom you are already in contact, or

b) You look for a new or host entrepreneur in the online catalogue with the help of your local contact point.

- Reach an agreement with your new or host entrepreneur about the work and learning project (dates, objectives and activity plan of the exchange) and submit the details to your local contact point
- Signature of Commitment to Quality: A Commitment to Quality (link) should be (digitally) signed by all partners involved in the relationship. NEs should equally conclude a funding agreement with your local contact point
- Start of the stay abroad: The duration of the exchange may be from 1 to 6 months with the possibility of dividing the stay into weekly slots (providing the time span does not exceed a total of 12 months)

The financial assistance to the new entrepreneur will be provided in several payments, according to the agreement signed with his/her local contact point.







When are you planning to start your own business?



To what extend did the NE contribute to the development of your business


Overall, would you conclude that the relationship has been successful?
