

MANAGING COMPANY OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY PARK OF CRETE SA

The Managing Company of the Science & Technology Park of Crete (EDAP SA) was founded in December 1993, with 20 shareholders mainly from the private sector. The Foundation for Research and Technology-Hellas (FORTH-HELLAS) and the Bank of Piraeus are the main shareholders, holding 63% of the shares.

The General Assembly is the supreme managing body of the Company. Currently, the Management Board consists of 9 members, elected by the General Assembly for a five-year duty.

The main goal of EDAP SA is the management of the premises and facilities where the Incubatees are located, alongside secretarial support and administration of operations. In addition, EDAP SA aims to support and promote innovative entrepreneurship, while providing funding to new business ventures, mostly spin-offs and start-ups, with long-term growth potential.

The Company has established an international network of business and research partners for the promotion of innovation and entrepreneurship.
